## Chemistry:

- Two 1.5" or 2" 3-ring binders
- Standard (College) ruled **loose-leaf ONLY** notebook paper
  - Note: please do not use tear out/spiral notebook paper
- Graph paper (Scientific/Science grid)
- 1 black or blue pen (optional)
- Red pen/pencil supply for correcting papers
- Scientific Calculator
- Straightedge
- "Lab/IRP" Composition Notebook (Graphing Grids not Lined)

## Spanish II & III

- 7 presentation folders with 3 prongs
- Spanish-English Dictionary that includes:
  - Pronunciation Guide
  - Parts of Speech/Gender

## Bible III:

- ½" binder for handouts & returned work
- 5 clear plastic sleeves & dividers
- Journal or sketchbook of choice for regular journaling and in-class activities (lined or unlined paper)
