Yearbook

- Digital camera (optional but recommended)
- Computer with internet access available for homework

Chemistry:

- Two 1.5" or 2" 3-ring binders
- Standard (College) ruled **loose-leaf ONLY** notebook paper
 - Note: please do not use tear out/spiral notebook paper
- Graph paper (Scientific/Science grid)
- 1 black or blue pen (optional)
- Red pen/pencil supply for correcting papers
- Scientific Calculator
- Straightedge
- "Lab/IRP" Composition Notebook (Graphing Grids not Lined)

A.P. Human Geography:

- 3-ring binder (1.5" minimum)
- Loose leaf notebook paper
- Highlighters
- Pencils

A.P. Psychology:

- 3-subject spiral bound notebook with pockets
- Colored pens including blue and black
- Index cards – 3 x 5

Physics, PreCalc and AP Calculus:

- Notebook & paper (spiral notebooks OK **IF** they have perforated edges so that paper can be torn out cleanly)
- Pencils & erasers (pen not accepted for homework)
- Ruler and/or straightedge
- Graph paper (all graphing for homework must be done on graph paper)
- Calculator (scientific calculator is the minimum requirement, graphing calculators are **REQUIRED**, recommended brands are TI and HP)

- Dot Grid Journal – to be purchased from school office \$10
- Variety of your favorite colored pencils and pens

Rock Climbing

- \$45 per semester if renting shoes and harness

(1) There are a few cameras available to rent through the school, the rental rate is \$150.00 + a \$50.00 refundable deposit if the camera is returned in good condition.

If you are in the market for a new camera or would rather buy than rent I can help you find a solution within your budget. If it is possible with your budget I would recommend the Canon SL2 as a starting point. Canon refurbished currently offers this camera with a lens and 1 year warranty for \$400.00

There are many, many cameras to choose from at a variety of price points, these cameras however offer a good variety of features as well as interchangeable lenses.

(2) Tripod - You will have advanced noticed before needing to bring a tripod to class. You can purchase a decent tripod on Amazon, Goodwill or ask around and borrow one. When shopping, consider the more metal that is on the tripod (particularly the head where the camera attaches) the better off you will be in the long term.

3) Printing - Most photos will be turned in digitally, however, we will require printed works periodically and you will need to have those ready at the start of class. Advanced notice will be given so you have time to arrange for bringing those to class.
