- Camera with manual control over Shutter, Aperture and ISO settings (1)
- Tripod (2)

(1) Having your own camera is optimal, however, the school has cameras available to rent for a small fee, if one is not available. Rental information will be available in August 2021.

There are many, many cameras to choose from at a variety of price point. Used cameras online can offer a good variety of features as well as interchangeable lenses.

(2) Tripod - You will have advanced noticed before needing to bring a tripod to class. You can purchase a decent tripod on Amazon, Goodwill or ask around and borrow one. When shopping, consider the more metal that is on the tripod (particularly the head where the camera attaches) the better off you will be in the long term.
